

CASHCARD OR 'MECHY' BINGO

IN-HOUSE GAMES

There are lots of different variations of cashcard games you can play, each club will play games in varying orders.

Most clubs also have a policy in play, this means that the games are automatically listed for each session and as a caller, it is your job to sell these games effectively.

- These are your standard games, these included but aren't limited to:
 - o 50p Games;
 - 50p Red line Free
 - 50p Red and White lines Free
 - 50p Blue and Yellow lines Free

 - o £1 Games;
 - £1 Full house Game
 - £1 red line Free Game
 - £1 Blue line Free Game
 - £1 Multi win Game (line then Full house)

 - o £2 Games

SETTING UP JACKPOT GAMES

Jackpot games are cashcard games played for a Full House (all 16 numbers are in play) with jackpot prize amounts in play.

Jackpot games include, 55 Special Games, National Cash Games & Red-Hot Jackpot Games – each of these has its own jackpot amount.

There are different procedures when setting up the jackpot games;

1. When these games are next in line on the policy, a box will appear at the side letting you know it will be a jackpot game - click 'yes' to confirm.
2. After clicking yes, the menu will appear showing the jackpot games. Use the arrow keys to find the correct game then click 'enter; to select the game.
 - Make sure it is the correct game and session, as there is an afternoon and evening option
3. Once you have selected the correct game, the box in the middle of the screen will show you the jackpots that are in play.
 - You need to click delete before you will be able to generate a number
4. When the game is finished, you will need to click 'delete' again before resetting the game.

55 Special Games

The 55 special is the easiest jackpot to win on cashcard – to win this the customer needs to call the Full House in 55 numbers or less to win an extra £100.

- An example of how you would sell a 55 Special Game:
 - o “We are now going to play a 55 Special Game. It is a straight through Full House game, all 16 numbers are in play - there are no free squares, your first number out is Red 14”
 - o “Mark it off if you’ve got it, you are off to a good start,”

- “£1 to play 55 Special Game then, definitely the easiest jackpot to win, call in 55 numbers or less to win £100!”
- “If you want to double up your chances just pop in another £1 coin and light up that lucky B board”
- “Red 14 is your first then, if we’re all ready? Here’s the rest.”

National Cash Game

This is also a straight through full house with all 16 numbers in play. There are 2 different Jackpot’s available:

1. Call on 45 numbers or less to win an extra £5000
2. Call on 46-50 numbers to win an extra £100

- An example of how to sell a National Cash Game:
 - “We are now going to play a National Cash Jackpot game, it is a straight through Full House game, all 16 numbers are in play”
 - “If you call your full house on 45 numbers or less you get an extra £5000, just miss out and call it on 46 to 50 numbers and you still get an extra £100.”
 - “Red 14 is your first number out, if you’ve got it mark it off you are off to a great start”
 - “Make sure the board you are playing is the board that is lit and if you want to activate a second board, pop in another £1”
 - “National Cash Jackpot game then, just call the full house on 45 numbers or less to win an extra £5000 or 46 to 50 numbers gets you an extra £100”
 - “Red 14 is your first number out then, if we’re all in and ready here’s the rest.”

CALLING NON-JACKPOT OR 'NORMAL' GAMES

When calling cash bingo, it is important to let the customers know what type of game it you are playing, how much it is to play and how much prize money it will be paying. You need to sell these games in an engaging way to encourage as many people to play as possible.

- An example of how to sell a 'normal' game:
 - o "We are going to play a £1 to play, Red Line Free game"
 - o "Red Line Free game then, so cover up your red numbers you don't need to find them on this game,"
 - o "Your first number out is yellow 25, mark it off if you've got it, you are off to a good start"
 - o "Usual reminder then, make sure the board you are playing is the board that is lit."
 - o "If you want to double up your chances, pop another £1 coin in and light up the B board"
 - o "Yellow 25 is your first number, prize money is up and over £25"
 - o "£1 to play Red Line Free, if we're ready then? Here's your next..."
